Pupil Premium Funding

What is Pupil Premium funding?

Pupil Premium funding is additional financial support that is provided by the government and which is allocated to schools to meet the needs of certain pupils. For each pupil that qualifies the school receives a significant sum of money that is used to raise standards in the pupils who are eligible.

Does my child qualify for this additional support?

You may be eligible to apply for Pupil Premium funding if you receive any of the following...

- Income Support
- Income-Based Job Seeker's Allowance (JSA)
- Income-Related Employment and Support Allowance (ESA)
- Guarantee Element of State Pension Credit
- Universal credit
- Both Income-Based and Contribution-Based JSA/ESA if you receive the same amount for both.
- You should also qualify if you receive both but the Income-based amount is greater, but not if the contribution-based amount is greater
- Child Tax Credit and have an annual income, as assessed by HMRC, not in excess of £16,190 (and you are not entitled to Working Tax Credit)

Or if your child...

- has been looked after (their care is managed by the local authority) for 1 day or more
- was adopted from care on or after 30 December 2005, or left care under a special guardianship order or a residence order Or if either parent is in the Armed Forces

How do I apply?

Where a child is eligible for Pupil Premium funding their parents or carers must usually apply through the Local Authority. This can be done online at: <http://www.warwickshire.gov.uk/freeschoolmeals>

How does Milverton Primary School use the Pupil Premium funding to raise standards for pupils who are eligible?

The inclusion team work with class teachers and support staff to plan additional opportunities to meet the needs of all pupils in school. Funding provided through this grant is used to enhance this further and provide additional opportunities to pupils who are eligible.

During 2018-19 Pupil Premium funding expenditure included:

- Contributions enabling eligible pupils to participate in extra-curricular opportunities such as clubs and events
- Additional teacher time to support eligible pupils by providing small group learning opportunities
- Contributions allowing additional adults to spend more time working with pupils requiring additional support in school (teachers working as tutors, school counsellor, and additional Teaching Assistant time)
- Contributions enabling trained members of staff to work with, support and provide ongoing advice to families
- Input to support the relationship between the school and outside agencies to support individual pupils
- Funding towards special events including cluster projects to enrich the experiences of pupils
