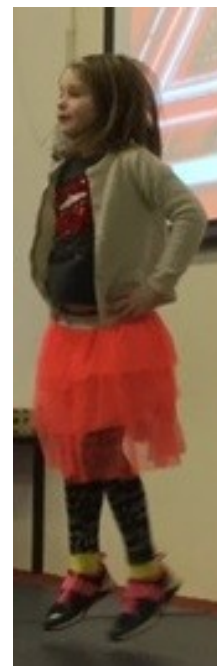

We also missed out on saying well done to Anniyah who was part of the team from 3/4. Well done to all!





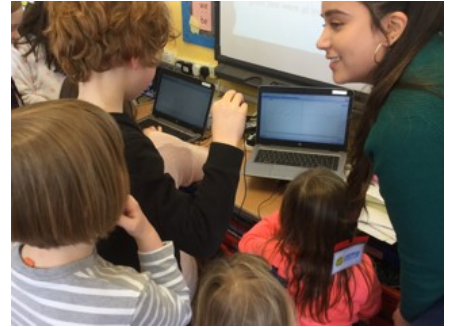


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## Mad Science
