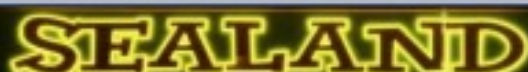

- GP+ clinicians will have access to your patient record – they will be able to see and update your medical history

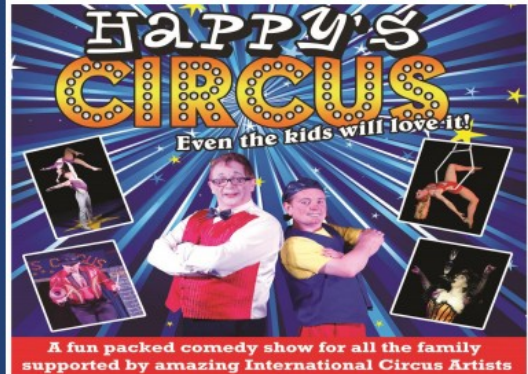

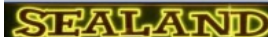
