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Safeguarding

Just a reminder that we do not teach children about stranger danger anymore, we teach them to be stranger aware. This is because in an emergency situation you may need the help of a stranger. So we discuss examples like if you were lost on a shopping trip and could not find your parents you may approach a person like a police officer or a staff member in a shop you have been in to ask for help.

We also talk about early warning signs: the feelings you get in a situation when things don't feel 'right'. Knowing what to do when you get early warning signs i.e. Speak to a friend and then a trusted adult about what gave you the early warning signs, are strategies we use to keep children safe. Talking about these issues before they arise is a good conversation to have with your child.

The super athletes took part in groups of ten in obstacle, running and balancing races against six other schools in the area.
